



D.O. Valdepeñas Viña Albali Weiß Lieblich

Inspired by the starry clear night, Félix Solís wanted to create a wine that reflects the joyful and lively spirit of the Spaniards. He named this wine Albali, after a star in the constellation of Aquarius.

The local Airén grape variety is, thanks to its resistance to heat, dry conditions and barren soils, the most widely planted grape variety in the world.

Regionen

The name Valdepeñas comes from the eponymous city from antiquity, located in a sun-drenched river valley, dotted with small rock formations - Val de peñas (Valley of the Rocks). Located south of Castile-La Mancha in central Spain, this region is almost completely enclosed by the production areas of the denomination of origin La Mancha D.O. and borders the south with Andalusia. The climate is dominated by extremes, with temperatures of up to 40°C in summer and down to -10°C in winter. The future of this denomination of origin lies in the hands of its red wines made from Tempranillo grapes, which are well suited for aging, such as the excellent Crianzas, Reservas and Gran Reservas.

Verkostungsnotizen

Light yellow lemon. Clean, fresh and fruity with herbaceous aromas in the nose. The low alcohol content and the balance between sweetness and acidity create a harmony and a special fineness, which on the palate is expressed by a light citrus flavor.

Suits particularly well with fish and seafood, especially with sardines and prawns, salads and even sweet desserts.

Technische Information

To produce this sweeter wine, the best grapes are selected. Thanks to modern viticultural techniques, this delicate wine is created. The fermentation is interrupted by cooling to the optimal time point.
